## White Wines by the Glass

- 101: El Caminador Sauvignon Blanc, *Central Valley, Chile* €8.75  
Attractive and complex nose, good mix of citric notes, tropical fruits and some subtle green - tones. Medium bodied and well - structured with excellent length.
- 102: San Giorgio Pinot Grigio, Garganega, *Verona, Italy* €8.95  
Straw yellow colour with greenish highlights and a delicate bouquet. Ripe, round and with a distinctly more character than most, with a crisp, refreshing finish.
- 103: Sire Cochet, Sauvignon - Grenache Blanc, *Languedoc, France* €8.95  
Delicate green fruit and herbal aromas, touch of peach and ripe melon. A bunch of fresh stone fruits on the palate, with a crisp and mineral-driven texture and a refreshing finish.
- 104: Chardonnay `Le Petit Moe`, Simone Joseph, *Languedoc, France* €11.50  
A light medium bodied wine from grapes grown in the hills to the west of Montpellier. Tank fermented, it has lovely honeyed fruit and plenty of freshness.
- 105: **Organic** "Collectables" Sauvignon Blanc, Walnut Block *Marlborough, New Zealand* €12.50  
Very lively and showing intense aromas of melon, citrus and passion fruit. Beautifully ripe and vividly fresh with a crisp, pure finish.

## Red Wines by the Glass

- 106: El Caminador Cabernet Sauvignon, *Chile* €8.75  
A smooth & juicy Cabernet with cassis, plum and fresh berries. A fruit driven palate which is complemented by a velvety finish.
- 107: Montepulciano d'Abruzzo," Il Bucco", *Abruzzo, Italy* €10.00  
Barnstorming with lively, sweet dark fruits and a nice kick on the finish.
- 108: Sire Cochet, Merlot – Grenache, *Languedoc, France* €8.75  
A basket of fresh red and black fruits, with charming notes of black cherry and hints of rosemary. This wine is very smooth and round, with a juicy profile and fine-grained tannins.
- 109: **Organic** Malbec, Domaine Bousquet, *Mendoza, Argentina* €11.50  
An aromatic, heady bouquet of raspberry, bitter chocolate and spice leads to a juicy and rich palate with layers of lush black cherry, mocha and mineral.
- 110: Crianza DO, Bodegas Montebuena, *Rioja Alavesa, Spain* €14.00  
The use of French oak complements the openly fruity character of the wine, adding some cinnamon and toasted vanilla notes to the aroma's finish.

128: Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, €28.00  
*Zenato, Italy*

Straw yellow colour with greenish highlights and a delicate bouquet. Riper, rounder and distinctly more characterful than most, with a crisp, refreshing finish.

## Reds

129: El Caminador Cabernet Sauvignon, €20.00  
*Central Valley, Chile*

A smooth & juicy Cabernet with cassis, plum and fresh berries. A fruit driven palate which is complemented by a velvety finish.

136: **Organic** Chateau Carbonneau Bordeaux Blanc “Margot” €55.00

Domaines Schlumberger

Picked a week later than most other whites in the region to gain tropical expressions. This is a textural Sauvignon Blanc blended with 5% Semillon displaying lovely tension and balance.

#### Loire Valley

137: Domaine de la Vinconierre, Musclet Serve et Maine Sur Lie €42.00

A shiny straw yellow colour, strong nose with hawthorn, citrus and lemon aromas.

A fresh, harmonious, concentrated palate!

138: Daniel Crochet Sancerre €60.00

Pale gold with green reflections in colour. The nose is quite Earthy with hints of dried herbs and citrus aromas. The palate is rich and clean with gooseberry, grass and a touch of smokiness.

139: Domaine Chatelain Pouilly Fume €55.00

Pale gold in colour. Grapefruit and light gooseberry aromas on the nose. Medium bodied with an elegant touch of minerality on the palate, medium acidity and a note of citrus fruit on the finish.

#### Maconnais

140: Cave Talmard, Macon – Uchizy €55.00

Unoaked, medium bodied with a lovely citrus/ripe pear flavour and a long, crisp finish. Precise fresh attack opening on a nice delicacy. Expressing a beautiful fat and a certain crunch, nice balance and freshness.

#### Burgundy

141: Chablis, Domaine William Fèvre €80.00

Very refined bouquet, developing citrus, white-fleshed fruit and floral notes. Fresh and supple, the wine is marked by mineral notes that are typical of the appellation.

142: Pouilly – Fuisse, “Les Villages”, Vins Auvigue €95.00

Chalky soils give this “Les Crays” it’s character. It expresses delicate floral aromas with hints of undergrowth and citrus fruit On the nose, fresh aromas of white flowers, fruits (pear, wild peach) and a few woody notes. The palate is rich, round, mineral with tension.

143: Chablis 1er Cru, Montée de Tonnerre, Louis Michel, €150.00

A perfect balance between fresh minerality and very ripe fruit. Warm, delicious and salty on the palate with a spicy, cinnamon finish.

#### Languedoc

145: Sire Cochet, Sauvignon - Grenache Blanc €39.00

Delicate green fruit and herbal aromas, touch of peach and ripe melon. A bunch of fresh stone fruits on the palate, with a crisp and mineral-driven texture and a refreshing finish.





146: Chardonnay `Le Petit Moe`, Vin de France, Simone Joseph €40.00  
A light medium bodied wine from grapes grown in the hills to the west of Montpellier. Tank fermented, it has lovely honeyed fruit and plenty of freshness. Slightly oaked but oh so pure Chardonnay.

## Spain

### Rueda

147: Verdejo DO Rueda, Val de Vid €49.00  
Fresh, elegant smooth and well structured. Tasty, aromatic, with easy palate. Complex and persistent finish with pleasantly bitter nuances typical of this variety. An unusually good mouthfeel due to ageing on lees.

### Rias Baixas

148: Atlantic Way, Albarino €59.00  
Delicious lime and mineral character. Crisp, fresh with a lime, mineral and slightly saline quality but with good mouthfeel. Excellent, clean finish.

## Austria

### Kremstal

150: **Organic** Crazy Creatures, Gruner Veltliner, Michael Malat €55.00  
Fresh, light and crisp perfect – perfect for any occasion and it's organic!

## Italy

### Tuscany

152: Bianco Toscana IGT, Villa Antinori €55.00  
The nose is intense and refined with notes of orange blossoms that lead over to fruity aromas of pineapples, Golden apples ,and bananas. The palate is fresh, pleasantly tense, defined by mouth filling flavours and a mineral finish.

### Puglia

153: Chardonnay IGT, Tormaresca €49.00  
The nose predominantly fruity with sensations of apples and citrus fruit rind, delicately floral with notes of acacia flowers and hawthorn. Fresh on the palate and well balanced with light balsamic notes.

### Verona

154: San Giorgio Pinot Grigio, Garganega €39.00  
Straw yellow colour with greenish highlights and a delicate bouquet. Ripe, round and with a distinctly more character than most, with a crisp, refreshing finish.

### Piemonte

156: La Chiara, Gavi di Gavi €60.00  
An explosion of freshness with this well-made Cortese grape variety. There's hints of pear and white flowers. Fresh, elegant fruit with an evident peach style bursts through on a palate that is well structured. Perfect with fish and white meat.

157: 3 Rios, Anselmo Mendes

€50.00

The nose reveals a tropical and elegant fruit aroma. Fruity and mineral aromas.

### Alentejo

158: "Florao" White, Quinta Da Fonte Souto

€60.00

Symington Family Estates Lively, bright aromatic expression of green apples, mango, and a touch of pineapple, ending with floral, honeysuckle notes. The palate is spry and crisp with fine acidity defining citric undertones, which introduce melon, lemon, and golden plum flavours.

159: Sauvignon Blanc - Chenin, Swallows' Tale

€40.00

A refreshing acidic lift on the finish leaves a pleasing citrus taste on the palate. "Aromatic and elegant, the bright herbal notes of the Sauvignon Blanc is contrasted by the undertones of the tropical nuances of the Chenin Blanc.

### Cape South Coast

160: Chardonnay Sans Barrique, Bouchard Finlayson

€65.00

Full and expressive, with luxurious aromas of Golden Delicious apple and fresh cream, wound around a pure and precise core. Succulent texture and fresh lemon rind flavours bring balance and focus into a substantial finish

163: **Organic** Chardonnay, Dog Point Vineyard

This stylish, single-vineyard Chardonnay is considered to be one of the best in New Zealand. A pure, bright and youthful citrus driven Chardonnay with flint, toast and biscuit notes derived from extended barrel aging on full solids. Characterized by a lovely structure with a moderate sweetness, a great aromatic purity and a very pleasant vivacity making a well-balanced and fruity wine, ideal as an aperitif.

### France

#### Languedoc

173: Sire Cochet, Merlot – Grenache

€39.00

A basket of fresh red and black fruits, with charming notes of black cherry and hints of rosemary. This wine is very smooth and round, with a juicy profile and fine-grained tannins.

174: Pinot Noir Grande Cuvée IGP, Les Argelieres

€40.00

Lovely aromas of raspberry and cherry, subtle smoky, and peppery hints with notes of thyme. Fruity, elegant, well balanced with a long finish.

### Burgundy

#### Beaujolais

175: Fleurie, Domaine Leyre Loup

€65.00

A lovely concentration of fruit deriving from the very old vines used. Attractive berry fruit aromas on the nose follow through to an elegant rich structured finish.

#### Cotes de Nuits

177: Gevrey Chambertin Gerard Seguin, La Justice

€170.00

Light Red in colour. Wild red berry fruit scents cut with earth, game and floral hints on the nose. Mineral driven, middle weight flavours combined with a fresh acidity culminate in a beautifully balanced long finish





## Bordeaux, (Right Bank)

### St. Emilion

178: Chateau Melin Saint-Emilion Grand Cru

€90.00

This Saint Emilion is supple, fresh and polished, leaving you with the sensation of lushness on the palate that carries through to the finish.

## Bordeaux, (Left Bank)

### St Estephe

181: Château Tour des Termes AOP Saint Estèphe

€130.00

2ème Cru Classé

This estate is owned by Irishman Dr Eddie O'Connor. Good colour with a concentrated nose. Quite intense with distinct cassis notes, the palate is very forward despite its relative youth. Very impressively packed with fruit, yet most refined; with complexity, fine balance and a very long finish.

### Pauillac

183: Echo de Lynch Bages

€230.00

Echo de Lynch-Bages is both supple and powerful. It releases fresh fruit aromas, elegantly underlined with the oaky and spicy notes acquired from ageing. On the palate, it is perfectly balanced and its tannins are already round and mouth coating.

### St Julien

184: Fiefs De La Grange

€120.00

Deep ruby in colour. Medium bodied with plummy ripe red and black fruits and a touch of cedar oak. Full bodied and well structured with round tannins.

185: La Réserve de Léoville-Barton

€180.00

The nose develops notes of balsamic, ink and pencil lead. The wine is well-balanced with a spicy touch and beautiful black fruits. Sensations of power and density. Beautiful length.

## Rhone Valley

### Southern Rhone

188: **Organic** Côtes du Rhône `Cuvée d`Alizée`, Les Deux Cols

€59.00

Produced by Irish Wine Maker Simon Tyrrell. A bright ruby colour with floral and red fruit aromas. The palate is light with a silky texture, fine tannins and fresh acidity that helps prolong the flavours.

189: Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Mas Saint Louis, Southern Rhone

€110.00

Grenache/Syrah/Cinsault. Deep, purple ruby colour. Expressive nose of red & black fruits; balanced & fresh on the palate with fat, wrapped tannins. Delicate, lingering finish.

### Cahors

190: Cahors, Malbec du Clos AOC, Clos Triguedina

€65.00

Intense and bright. Elegant, generous aromas of dark fruits on the nose with a rich, smooth and fruity palate. Quite intense nose with red berries and sweet cherries.





## Spain

### Rias Baixas

191: La Multa Garnacha, El Escoces Volante

€45.00

Mid to deep purple in colour, with pronounced intense primary raspberry, cherry and prune varietal fruit characters with complex, earthy notes of spice and leather. A full-bodied wine with fine, soft tannins and well-balanced acidity. Soft raspberry and wild berry fruits give way to a long, smooth, spicy finish.

### Rioja

192: Crianza DO Rioja, Bodegas Montebuena

€45.00

The use of French oak complements the openly fruity character of the wine, adding some cinnamon and toasted vanilla notes to the aroma's finish.

## Portugal

### Alto Alentejo

194: Florao Red, Quinta Da Fonte Souto

€60.00

A cool growing cycle shows through on the elegance and clarity of the aromas, which range from pine and eucalyptus to a lovely rose garden scent. There are also hints of raspberry and kirsch.

### Upper Douro

195 : Pombal do Vesuvio DOC, Symington Family Estates

€98.00

On the palate, it shows itself powerful and tense, still a little reserved, but reveals an enormous gastronomic profile. The fine-grained tannins give a touch of spice and underpin the powerful structure of the wine whose acidity provides freshness and balance.

## Italy

### Montalcino

196: Brunello Di Montalcino

€150.00

This Rosso di Montalcino DOC has a ruby red colour. The nose expresses notes of citrus and fresh red fruit such as cherries and strawberries alternating with pleasant sensations of lavender and tobacco.

### Bolgheri

197: Il Bruciato DOC, Tenuta Guado Al Taso, Marchesi

€90.00

Antinori

Il Bruciato offers an intense ruby red colour. On the nose, the aromas of ripe red berry fruit, sweet spices, and a light and fresh minty note are the most prominent sensations.

### Abruzzo

198: Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, "Il Bucco"

€39.00

Barnstorming with lively, sweet dark fruits and a nice kick on the finish.

### Verona

199: Valpolicella Superiore, Zenato

€50.00

Delicious ripe, rounded cherry and blackcurrant fruits with a beautifully smooth finish.





## Puglia

200: Neprica Primitivo IGT, Tormaresca

€49.00

Red fruit, black cherries, with hints of candied fruit and liquorice as well. Soft in its initial sensations, supple tannins and structured. Well sustained by a balanced freshness.

## Tuscany

201: Chianti Superiore, Santa Cristina

€55.00

This classic Chianti offers spicy aromas along with notes of red fruit which recall cherries. The palate is fragrant and is endowed with a texture of supple tannins.

202: Rosso Toscana IGT, Villa Antinori

€69.00

Villa Antinori shows an intense ruby red colour. There is red fruit, cherries and plums along with berry fruit and mint, well balanced with the sensations of spices and vanilla from the oak barrels.

203: Chianti Classico, Pèppoli Estate DOCG

€69.00

The delicate bouquet is completed with floral notes of hyacinth blossoms and spicy hints of unsweetened cocoa powder. A mouth filling entry on the palate is sustained by lively freshness.

## Argentina

### Mendoza

#### Tupungato Valley/Uco Valley

205: **Organic** Malbec Reserve, Domaine Bousquet

€55.00

The nose follows through on that promise with red berry aromas, dried mushroom, prune and spice. Medium bodied with soft, silky tannins and a powerful finish. Classic Mendoza Malbec, this wine loves a steak or a barbeque.

206: **Organic** Malbec, Domaine Bousquet

€45.00

An aromatic, heady bouquet of raspberry, bitter chocolate and spice leads to a juicy and rich palate with layers of lush black cherry, mocha and mineral.

## New Zealand

### Marlborough

207: **Organic** Dog Point Vineyard Pinot Noir

€120.00

An organic plush Pinot Noir with pure red berry flavours. The wines cleansing Acidity and fine, soft tannins are evident, characteristic of Marlborough's clay based Southern Valley soils.

## Chile

### Maipo Valley

208: Altum Cabernet Sauvignon, Vina Terra Mater

€69.00

Plenty of red and black ripe berry fruit well assembled with some balsamic touches and some spicy notes Elegant and full bodied in the mouth. Good balance acidity gives a freshness sensation in the palate. Soft tannins with a long and persistent aftertaste.





## Central Valley

209: El Caminador Cabernet Sauvignon

€38.00

A smooth & juicy Cabernet with cassis, plum and fresh berries.  
A fruit driven palate which is complemented by a velvety finish.

210: Family Reserve Merlot, Puna Snipe **Organic**

€40.00

Bright ruby-red in colour, with red fruits aromas, especially berries, elegantly combined with black pepper notes. On the palate, it presents a delicate wood influence that contributes with great complexity, good structure and rounded tannins. It has a soft texture and a fruity finish.

## South Africa

### Elim

212: Shiraz - Cabernet Sauvignon, Swallows' Tale

€39.00

Rich and ripe bramble fruits offer an appealing rounded palate. Ripe tannins and sustaining acid give some structure to the wine. Expressive red fruits and spiciness from the Shiraz, blends meticulously well with the Cabernet's nuances of pine forest, creating an aromatically delicious wine

### Walker Bay

214: Hannibal, Bouchard Finlayson

€120.00

A thought-provokingly unique blend. Aromatic leather, cured meat and violet notes frame flavours of red cherry and rooibos tea. Surprisingly taut and fine grained, it displays polish and intense complexity. Hints of tobacco on the finish, while fresh acidity keeps the balance.
