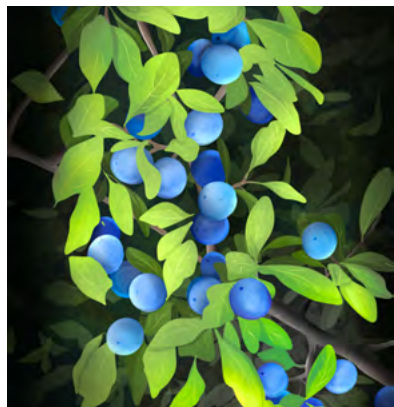
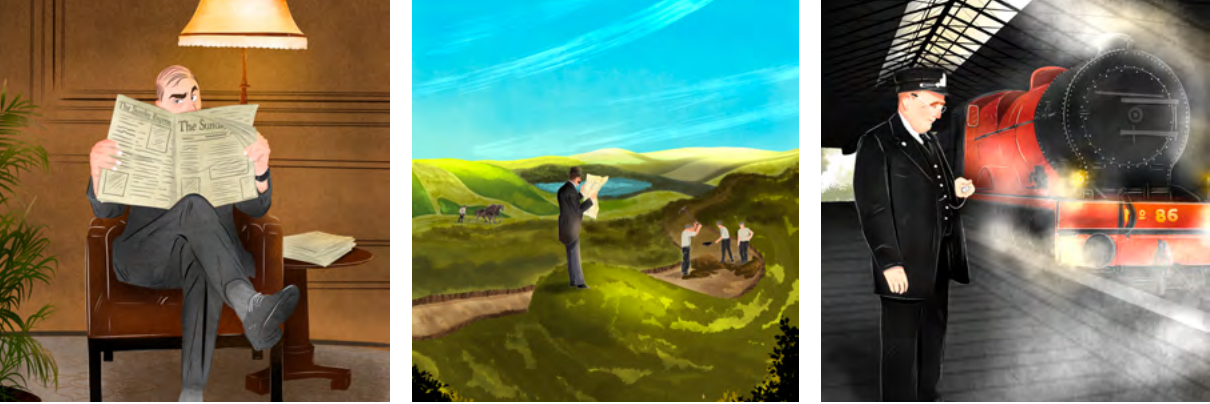

The Story.

The 6th Earl of Kenmare, Viscount Castlerosse, epitomized flamboyance in the 20th century aristocracy. Renowned as a playboy and the first British aristocrat to write a gossip column, his “*Londoners’ Log*” in *The Sunday Express* was both extravagant and scandalous. At 18 stone, he indulged in excesses, living lavishly on foie gras at renowned establishments like Claridge’s and the Savoy.

His compulsively readable column, spanning 18 years, compelled high society to secure multiple newspapers, ensuring no guest could claim the cachet of reading Castlerosse’s scandalous revelations first!

The Story.

In 1747, Thomas Browne assumed control of the Kenmare Estate, returning to a seemingly desolate Killarney. Undeterred, he transformed the landscape, draining bogs, constructing roads, and fostering agricultural development.

His investment in public works left an indelible mark on Killarney.

Notably, Browne's foresight in promoting Killarney as a tourist destination cemented his enduring legacy, marking a pivotal chapter in the town's transformation.

His nomadic childhood, from Westminster to Douai in France, Oxford, and finally County Kerry, inspired our reimagined classic Irish Coffee, encapsulating the diverse journey that shaped Sir Thomas Browne's legacy.

The Story.

In the wake of the inaugural Dublin-Kerry railway, the Great Southern and Western Railway sought a site for a “*Grand Hotel*” in Killarney. Choosing Lord Kenmare’s estate, they demanded 40 acres for station and hotel - **free of charge**. A dilemma arose as the coveted land housed part of Lord Kenmare’s cherished garden.

Despite initial reluctance, Lord Kenmare acknowledged the benefits and eventually agreed under two conditions:

- 1. The Brownes would have free rail travel whenever they wished.*
- 2. Should they be delayed getting to the station, the train in question would hold departure until the Brownes had boarded safely!*

The Story.

“Ladies View” in Killarney National Park, a testament to its regal history, provides breathtaking panoramas of the Lakes of Killarney and the Macgillicuddy Reeks. Originating from Queen Victoria’s 1861 visit (*at the invitation of the Browne and Herbert families*), her mesmerized ladies-in-waiting inspired the name. Symbolizing both royal admiration and timeless allure, it remains a cherished destination.

In tribute to Queen Victoria’s penchant for single malt, a local dram stars in our Penicillin variation, shaken with fresh lemon and ginger honey. A nod to Her Majesty’s love for scotch and claret, a red wine float elevates the concoction.





LAND AND SKY

Intertwined with the classic duo of Campari and Vermouth this cocktail celebrates the picturesque landscape that these two iconic animals call home.

The Story.

In Killarney National Park, the red deer, Ireland's sole native species, can be spotted year-round, particularly during the rutting season in autumn. The white-tailed eagle graces the skies around the park, often near lakeshores and woodlands. Spring and summer offer ideal times for eagle sightings, particularly soaring over the Lakes.

Our signature Negroni is crafted using a 700-year-old recipe, a herbaceous spirit drink rooted in the birthplace of Irish whiskey. Intertwined with the classic duo of Campari and Vermouth, this cocktail celebrates the picturesque landscape that these two iconic animals call home.

The strawberry tree (*Arbutus unedo*) in Killarney National Park is a botanical gem, adding to the park's biodiversity. Endemic to Ireland and the Mediterranean, it graces the park's woodlands with evergreen foliage and distinctive strawberry-like fruit. Renowned for its resilience, the tree survives in diverse habitats. Its bell-shaped flowers bloom in autumn, providing late-season nourishment for pollinators.

The strawberry tree's presence not only contributes to the park's ecological diversity but also enhances the aesthetic appeal of its landscapes.

The Story.

In Killarney National Park, mint, nettle, elderflower, and fennel thrive, gracing the local area with their aromatic richness. Mint flourishes in gardens and along water bodies, infusing its refreshing flavour into teas. Elderflower blossoms adorn hedgerows, while fennel's aromatic fronds grace gardens and natural habitats.

These botanicals not only enhance local cuisine but also tie in perfectly with the creations of our colleagues in Bloom, the stunning glass bar situated in the manicured courtyard gardens of our sister hotel, Hayfield Manor in Cork.





BLACKTHORN

A seasonal delight that reflects the natural abundance and cultural richness of Killarney National Park.

Bertha Sloe Gin, Skellig Six 18, Martini Rosso,

The Story.

In Killarney National Park, the blackthorn (*Prunus spinosa*) blooms in early Spring with white flowers, bearing the prized sloe berry. This dark purple fruit holds cultural significance, traditionally used in crafting the cherished local beverage, sloe gin. Locals forage for the bitter sloe berries, crafting homemade versions of this traditional spirit.

Beyond enhancing biodiversity, the blackthorn and its sloe berries intertwine with local traditions, offering a seasonal delight that reflects the natural abundance and cultural richness of Killarney National Park.





FIRST STEPS

This non-alcoholic option is inspired by an amphibious creature's first movements from sea to land, balancing zesty citrus with cooling notes of cucumber.

The Story.

385 million years ago, a primitive vertebrate (*Tetrapod*) walked through the muddy coastline of Ireland's Valentia Island, leaving behind tracks that have remarkably survived to this day. These are some of the oldest fossilised footprints found anywhere in the world and are a fascinating example of the transition of life from sea to land.

Inspired by the coastal landscape and this amphibious creature's movement from the sea to the land we created a cocktail which balances zesty citrus with the cooling notes of cucumber.

The Story.

The glacial lake known as **The Devil's Punchbowl** lies 838m up, in the hollow of Mangerton Mountain. The lake takes its name from a folklore legend in which Chieftain O'Donoghue Ross dined with the devil on Mangerton, where they ended up arguing.

O'Donoghue punched the beast in its face, making a swift escape down the mountain and leaving the Devil to bite a chunk out of the summit in his anger.

In Ireland, there are four distinct styles of whiskey, each boasting its own unique characteristics. These styles include Single Grain, Single Pot, Single Malt, and Blended. Below, we've curated a selection of four diverse whiskeys that exemplify these individual styles.

Single Grain

Bushmills 10 Yr. - €10.00

Single grain whiskey is made from a blend of grains at a single distillery, often using column stills, resulting in a lighter flavor profile compared to single malt whiskey.

Single Pot

Green Spot - €12.50

Single pot still whiskey, is made exclusively in Ireland, from a mash of malted and unmalted barley in a single distillery's traditional copper pot still, imparting a rich, full-bodied flavor with spicy and fruity notes.

Single Malt

Writers Tears Copper Pot - €9.00

Single malt whiskey is crafted from 100% malted barley at a single distillery, distilled in pot stills, offering a complex flavor profile with nuances of malt, fruit, and often a hint of peat smoke.
