The Story.

In the wake of the inaugural Dublin-Kerry railway, the Great Southern and Western Railway sought a site for a “*Grand Hotel*” in Killarney. Choosing Lord Kenmare’s estate, they demanded 40 acres for station and hotel - **free of charge**. A dilemma arose as the coveted land housed part of Lord Kenmare’s cherished garden.

Despite initial reluctance, Lord Kenmare acknowledged the benefits and eventually agreed under two conditions:

- 1. The Brownes would have free rail travel whenever they wished.*
- 2. Should they be delayed getting to the station, the train in question would hold departure until the Brownes had boarded safely!*

The Story.

The 6th Earl of Kenmare, Viscount Castlerosse, epitomized flamboyance in the 20th century aristocracy. Renowned as a playboy and the first British aristocrat to write a gossip column, his “*Londoners’ Log*” in *The Sunday Express* was both extravagant and scandalous. At 18 stone, he indulged in excesses, living lavishly on foie gras at renowned establishments like Claridge’s and the Savoy.

His compulsively readable column, spanning 18 years, compelled high society to secure multiple newspapers, ensuring no guest could claim the cachet of reading Castlerosse’s scandalous revelations first!



WHITE TAIL

A tribute to the majestic white-tailed eagle, soaring once more over Killarney's forests and lakes.

The Story.

Once a familiar sight along Ireland's coastline, the white-tailed eagle disappeared for generations before being successfully reintroduced to Killarney National Park in 2007.

Today, these magnificent birds once again soar above the lakes, forests and mountains that surround The Great Southern. This elegant cocktail reflects that journey, pairing bright citrus and delicate woodland botanicals with subtle coastal salinity to capture the wild beauty and quiet power of one of Ireland's most iconic native species.



THE SLOE WAY ROUND

Inspired by the wild sloe berries that have shaped Killarney's landscape for centuries.

Sloe Gin, Calvados, Five Farms Irish Cream Liqueur, Rhubarb Bitters, Breakfast Tea, Orgeat, Lemon - Milk Clarified

The Story.

The blackthorn, or sloe berry bush, grows throughout Killarney National Park and is so deeply rooted in the area's history that many believe it inspired the town's name.

This cocktail celebrates that connection through a beautifully clarified milk punch, revealing crystal-clear flavours of orchard apple, ripe berry and marzipan. The result is a drink that is both contemporary and nostalgic, honouring one of Killarney's oldest natural landmarks.



LINES IN STONE

A modern interpretation of Ireland's earliest written language.

Dingle Whiskey (or Vodka), Stillgarden Glas 55, Apple Cordial, Peach Bitters, Sparkling Oolong Tea

The Story.

Across the Dingle Peninsula stand ancient Ogham stones, their carved lines preserving Ireland's earliest known written language for more than fifteen centuries.

Inspired by these enduring monuments, this refreshing highball layers Irish whiskey or vodka with local botanicals, crisp orchard fruit and sparkling oolong tea. Herbal notes and fresh aromas evoke the moss-covered stones that continue to watch over the Kerry landscape today.



CLIFFSIDE

Inspired by the towering cliffs and sea mist of Ireland's Wild Atlantic Way.

This refreshing cocktail captures that landscape with locally distilled coastal vodka, bright citrus and fresh mint, delicately seasoned with sea botanicals. Crisp, elegant and unmistakably maritime, it evokes the cool sea breeze rolling in beneath the cliffs.

Nestled on Lough Leane, Innisfallen Island has been a place of quiet reflection for over a thousand years. Home to an early medieval monastery where monks recorded some of Ireland's earliest histories, it remains one of Killarney's hidden treasures.

This spirit-forward whiskey cocktail draws inspiration from that sense of calm and craftsmanship, combining rich herbal flavours, warming spice and delicate notes of hazelnut into a timeless classic.



100 STEP FALL

The Story.

Torc Waterfall is one of Killarney National Park's most celebrated landmarks, reached by a scenic stone pathway known locally as the Hundred Steps.

Surrounded by towering woodland and cascading water, the route is every bit as memorable as the destination itself. Bright citrus, pine and aromatic herbs recreate the freshness of the forest, while a vivid blue citrus accent recalls the waterfall tumbling over ancient rock.



RARE & WILD

A floral celebration of Kerry's remarkable native flora.

Killarney's ancient oak woodlands are among the last remaining native forests in Ireland, with some trees standing for hundreds of years. Beneath their dense canopy, mosses and ferns create an enchanting landscape that has inspired generations of visitors.

This contemporary take on an Old Fashioned reflects that timeless setting, combining Irish whiskey with rich notes of cacao, stout and walnut before being finished with fragrant oak smoke.

Irish whiskey and cold brew coffee are enriched with the bittersweet character of Irish amaro before being crowned with a smooth cacao-stout foam. A subtle note of locally sourced sweet woodruff adds a gentle herbal finish and a connection to the surrounding gardens.

This captivating tale of transformation inspired a cocktail that changes colour as it is poured, shifting from soft blue to vibrant purple. Delicate floral notes, fresh citrus and fragrant tea create a drink that is as elegant as the legend itself.



A WEEK OF SPRING

Celebrating the fleeting beauty of cherry blossom season.

The Story.

For just a brief period each Spring, the cherry blossom trees at Killarney House & Gardens burst into spectacular bloom before their petals are carried away on the breeze.

Inspired by the Japanese philosophy of Ichigo Ichie—treasuring each unrepeatable moment—this delicate tea cocktail combines Irish and Japanese influences in a floral infusion that continues to evolve as it rests, revealing new layers of flavour with every pour.



FIRST STEPS

This non-alcoholic option is inspired by an amphibious creature's first movements from sea to land, balancing zesty citrus with cooling notes of cucumber.

The Story.

385 million years ago, a primitive vertebrate (*Tetrapod*) walked through the muddy coastline of Ireland's Valentia Island, leaving behind tracks that have remarkably survived to this day. These are some of the oldest fossilized footprints found anywhere in the world and are a fascinating example of the transition of life from sea to land.

Inspired by the coastal landscape and this amphibious creature's movement from the sea to the land we created a cocktail which balances zesty citrus with the cooling notes of cucumber.

The Story.

The glacial lake known as **The Devil's Punchbowl** lies 838m up, in the hollow of Mangerton Mountain. The lake takes its name from a folklore legend in which Chieftain O'Donoghue Ross dined with the devil on Mangerton, where they ended up arguing.

O'Donoghue punched the beast in its face, making a swift escape down the mountain and leaving the Devil to bite a chunk out of the summit in his anger.
